This afternoon Governor Murphy addressed the State with an update on the Novel Coronavirus COVID-19. During his presentation he announced that New Jersey now has 50 presumptive positive cases.

I am just now getting off of a conference call with the Burlington County Department of Health and they have indicated that the cases have doubled in the last twenty-four hours and that another presumptive positive case has been determined in Burlington County.

Based on this information, and with the recommendation of the Burlington County Department of Health, we will make the following modifications to our schedule and be closed for students until April 20, 2020:

- March 17: Inclement Weather Day (no students)
- March 18: Inclement Weather Day (no students)
- March 19-March 31: Remote Instruction begins
- April 1 April 9: Remote Instruction
- April 10 April 19: Spring Recess
- April 20: Return

Effective immediately all athletic, extracurricular events, evening events and field trips will not take place.

Early next week you will receive direction regarding all matters around remote instruction in Delran Township Public Schools and our Pandemic Emergency Preparedness Plans. Please rest assured that I will remain in contact.
