District Summer Programming

There will be changes in our summer programming to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our students and staff.

- ESY (Extended School Year)
 - ESY will be conducted for eligible students through online instruction from July 6 to July 30, 2020.
- Basic Skills Instruction Summer Program (BSI)
 - Grades K-8 Basic Skills identified students will have the opportunity this summer to continue to develop skills in math and/or English language arts remotely online. The program will run Monday through Thursday from July 6 to July 30, 2020. Please look out for a survey regarding your interest in this opportunity in the near future.
- STEAM Camp
 - There will be no STEAM Camp offered this summer. We look forward to resuming with the program during the summer of 2021. Please look out for STEM Family Engagement Nights during the 2020-2021 school year.

ESY for Special Education Students

ESY will be provided through remote instruction with the same means as during the school year. The dates of ESY will be July 6 to July 30, 2020.

Services will be provided through the following means: Google Meet, Google Classroom, frequent check-in with identified students, and related services.

Information on Related Services

For Students that receive Related Services (OT, PT, or Speech) and Preschool Home <u>Program</u>:

The Related Service Staff will continue to offer a combination of video therapy (live or recorded), links to online videos to watch for modeling, practice activities, written work, and activities to be completed with a caregiver. Mostly all providers are using Google Classroom and google meets.

Related Services will continue in ESY as well through remote online instruction.
