Dear Parents and Guardians,

I am writing to provide you with an update regarding the closure of Delran High School and its status on a 100% remote learning schedule.

To date we have continued to receive positive COVID-19 test results and have students in the COVID-19 testing protocols. Due to these factors and, coupled with the responsibility to resume in person instruction at the most appropriate time, I have concluded through consultation with the Burlington County Department of Health that the resumption of in person instruction will be moved from October 20, 2020 to October 26, 2020.

It seems appropriate to outline the following practices that allow for the spread of COVID-19 to be mitigated:

- Stay home when you are sick. Avoid/Limit interactions with people that are sick. Wear a face mask when leaving your home. Practice social distancing by staying 6 feet apart.
- **Avoid gatherings that extend outside of your family circle.** By limiting close contact with individuals outside your home you will lower the risk of transmitting COVID-19. Individuals with COVID-19 may not have symptoms therefore they may not realize they are spreading the virus.
- If a household member has been exposed to COVID-19 or is symptomatic and requires COVID-19 testing, the entire household should either be COVID tested themselves or remain home awaiting COVID-19 test results and direction from your healthcare provider and the Department of Health.
