Dear Delran High School Parents and Guardians,

Onsite instruction for all in person Delran High School students will resume on **May 3, 2021**. Below is information for your consideration and review.

- Transportation: All bus routes will remain as-is. Additional bus routes will not be added. As a result the
 capacity loads will be maximized in comparison to what they were from September through April. Each
 vehicle will continue to have all windows open to provide air circulation. Additionally, all health mitigation
 protocols will continue. Parents have the option to drop their children off at school.
- Lunches: DHS Students will eat in the cafeteria, gymnasium, auxiliary gymnasium, outdoor tents and, if necessary, the Performing Arts Center or other defined spaces spaced six feet apart.
- As stated in previous correspondence, there will be no changing of cohorts in reaction to the change in instruction. All remote students will remain remote until the close of the year.

Mr. Finkle will follow up with his broadcast on Thursday, April 29th which will add specifics to this announcement.
