Dear Parents and Guardians,

As the calendar moves through May and into warmer weather, Executive Order 175 (EO 175) issued by Governor Murphy, provides permissibility in the Delran Township Board of Education *Restart and Recovery Plan* to have safety protocols under circumstances regarding face covering requirements in extreme outdoor heat.

Pursuant to EO 175, in consultation with the New Jersey Department of Health representatives, students are provided an exception to wearing a face covering outdoors while in extreme heat. Thus, students will not be required to wear a mask during recess or physical education while being exposed to extreme heat. Please note students may continue to do so if they or their parents/guardians wish.

Masks are still required inside all school school buildings and on busses.
